Enclosed is the scholarship application you requested from the Wayne L. Laufer Charitable Foundation. The Foundation awards scholarships to deserving students to provide them with the financial assistance needed to obtain an academic or professional degree. Particularly, the Foundation wishes to encourage students in smaller communities to study technical areas (particularly math, science, engineering and teaching in these areas) and pursue further education and related career paths in such areas. Scholarships are awarded on an objective and nondiscriminatory basis without regard to race. Scholarships range up to a maximum of \$40,000 per academic year and may be renewed upon application. Scholarship checks are sent to the school, and may be applied only towards tuition and enrollment fees and expenses for fees, books, supplies and equipment required for courses of instruction. Additional financial assistance for room, board and other expenses may also be available to applicants who demonstrate need.

Applicants must meet the following standards:

- Must be graduated or about to graduate from high school or its equivalent and be enrolled or about to enroll in an accredited college or university.
- Must be a student in a smaller community who desires to study technical areas (particularly math, science, engineering and teaching in these areas) and pursue further education and related career paths in such areas.
- Must submit a confidential application form to the Foundation.
- Must be or intend to be either an undergraduate at a college or university pursuing an academic or professional degree.
- Must meet the following criteria:

Demonstrate sufficient academic ability to enable the applicant to complete the courses of study necessary to graduate from, or complete the program at the educational institution at which the applicant is enrolled or about to enroll.

Demonstrate the character and motivation necessary to obtain an education and to work hard and seriously to continue that education.

Demonstrate the need for financial assistance to complete the applicant's studies.

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In addition to meeting the above-outlined standards as an initial applicant for a scholarship, in order to be considered for the renewal of a scholarship, the student will be expected to regularly provide official transcripts of his or her grades.

INSTRUCTIONS TO APPLICANTS SEEKING A FOUNDATION SCHOLARSHIP

It is our belief that a student pursuing an education should be able to read with comprehension and follow instructions as given. Please be advised that everything counts on your application. Neatness, legibility, spelling, grammar, and providing the information as requested are important points. Applicants who comply will be given consideration.

1. The application requires that some information be provided separately. However, it is to be considered as a whole in that when you sign the application you are attesting to the accuracy of all information furnished in connection with your application. Applications which are not signed and notarized will not be considered.
2. Income information is to be provided to us on a Federal Application for Student Financial Aid or "FASFA" form (or such other federal financial aid form as is currently in use). You should obtain a copy of this form from the financial aid office of the school you are attending or would like to attend. YOU must send us a copy of (A) your completed Federal Financial Aid form, (B) your Institutional Student Information Record or "ISIR," showing your "Effective Family Contribution" or "EFC" amount (or such other record of your processed federal financial aid form and/or such other financial needs number as are currently in use) and (C) the tax returns if any used to complete your financial aid form.

The financial aid form establishes whether you are emancipated. If your status requires that you complete the "Parents Information" sections of the FASFA form, then both you and your parent or guardian must sign this application form.

3. All grade information is to be provided to us on the official transcript(s) from your high school, college(s), or university(ies). FRESHMAN applicants pursuing an academic degree should request that the transcript show their SAT and/or ACT scores. YOU must arrange to have your transcript(s) delivered to us. The mailing of transcripts can take six or more weeks.
4. To continue to be eligible for our scholarship, you must be an undergraduate in an academic degree program or a student at an accredited school.
5. At least one letter of recommendation is required for all applicants. In addition to the required letter, you may know others who would be in a position to write a letter of recommendation for you. Such other letters would be of help to the Foundation's Directors. Include all letters of recommendation unopened, with your application, or have them sent to us directly.
6. The application form is designed to accommodate applications for different types of scholarships. Some sections may request information which does not apply to

you; to those, please respond "N/A" ("Not Applicable"). Some sections may request information which you do not yet know; to those, please respond "TBD" ("To Be Determined"). With regard to the courses in which you plan to enroll, we are requesting only the nature of the courses – e.g., one physics, one engineering, one math, one English, one marketing, and one political science course, etc. You must notify us if the courses you take depart from the nature of the courses shown on your application. To be sure you get the courses you need, we suggest early registration.

We have provided a copy of the application form. The application is to be returned to us with your letters of recommendation, narrative statement, and financial aid forms. Please feel free to provide additional information, if necessary, on a separate sheet of paper to enhance your answers to the application questions.
